AUSTRALIA WIDE:

In the 2006 census the population of Australia was 19,855,288 and is comprised of 49.4% males and 50.6% females.

The median/average age of the population of Australia is 37 years of age.

The main religious make up of Australia is 25.8% Catholic, 18.7% Anglican, 18.7% No Religion, 5.7% Uniting Church, 3% Presbyterian and Reformed.

49.6% of people are married, 33.2% have never married and 11.3% are separated or divorced. There are 936,813 widowed people living in Australia.

60.7% of the people living in Australia are employed full time, while 27.9% are employed on a part time basis. Australia had an unemployment rate of 5.2% and 5,271,116 people are not part of the labour force.
